PROJECT DESCRIPTION

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The Frampton Park Baptist Church is part of a scheme that creates three new residential blocks and one community building on the Frampton Park Estate in Hackney. The new church building replaces a 1950s church in poor condition and accommodates the thriving congregation's many activities and services, including a cafe, crèche, offices, a youth club and studio, all under one roof.

KLH was chosen due to the materials sustainability credentials and the programme advantage over 'traditional' building components. The building is brick clad with its internal surfaces predominantly of visual grade exposed KLH® - CLT.

CARBON CALCULATION

Total stored/sequestered carbon in the KLH panels for Frampton Park Baptist Church is 121 69 tonnes.

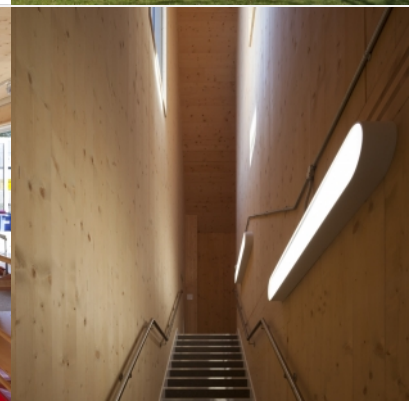
