WOODEN ARCHITECTURE AS A CENTRE FOR STUDY AND EXCHANGE

The NCKU Art Garden on the campus of National Cheng Kung University serves as a meeting place for students and alumni and brings together academic, artistic and social aspects. The building uses KLH® – CLT as the central building material. The multi-layered CLT elements offer high stability and load-bearing capacity and allow large spans without intermediate supports, which enables flexible spatial concepts and open inner courtyards. Two structures of different sizes create an atrium for various activities. The west side offers elevated, partially screened seating areas, while the east

side creates a bright and inviting atmosphere thanks to a recessed square design. The NCKU Art Garden combines innovative timber architecture with a traditional campus ambience, making it an inspiring place for the university community.
