PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The expansion and remodelling of the West London Academy, by Architects Co-Partnership, comprises of two new buildings and the refurbishment of the existing facilities to accommodate 210 primary age pupils. The project also provided the secondary school with additional state-of-the-art teaching spaces supporting the Academy's specialisms of Sport and Enterprise.

The new early years unit 'The Arc' added a new 52 place nursery, reception and Year One Key Stage 1 classrooms, increasing the primary element of the all-through Academy to three forms of entry.


A new Design and Technology Department, Art Department, ICT and media suite is housed within a purpose-built extension, named 'The Quad'. To enhance the out-of-hours community use of the Academy, 'The Quad' has been designed with a separate entrance, which provides a more welcoming environment for the public and enhanced pedestrian access routes.
