

KREISCHBERG

At the request of the client to create a diamond or rock-shaped building for a new peak restaurant, the architect decided to design the building as an abstracted eagle in a resting pose. The central theme was to find a building form was to capture the fantastic panorama.

A room height of 6 meters and glass panels of the same height offer probably the most spectacular view of landscape. The remining parts of facade also consists completely of glass, divided into opaque and transparent panels whereby no pane of glass is identical to another.

The guest room was defined with large visible glue laminated timber and KLH® – ceiling elements. In the design of the interior, the materials of wood, stone, felt and leather were combined in a perfect interplay.

The KLH® – CLT elements were delivered via the ski slope of the six-seater chairlift.


